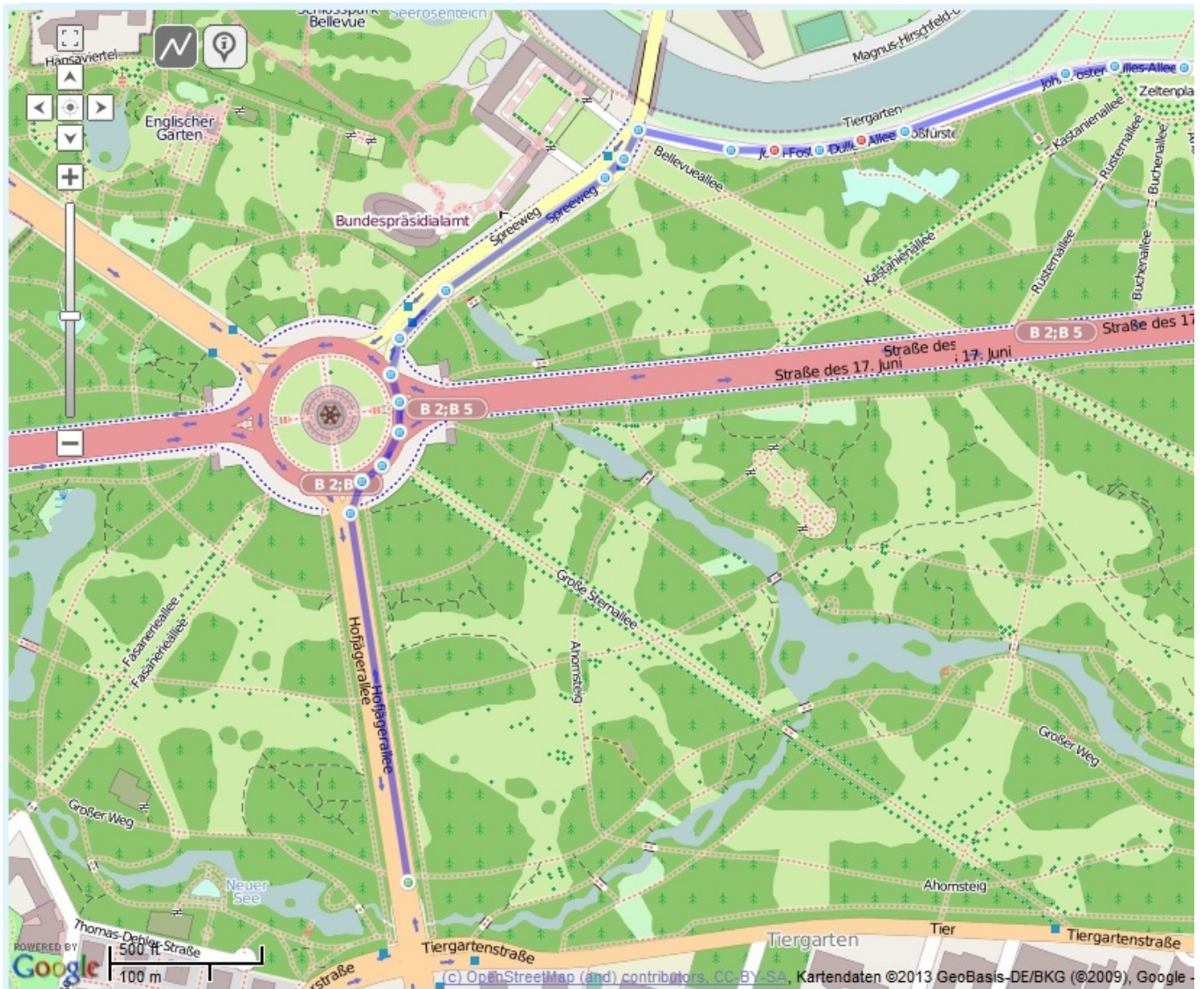



How to create a track with automatic navigation arrows?


The free online platform gpsies.com allows you download gpx tracks with automatic navigation arrows, generated by gpsies.com





1. Search for a route you want to go for or create your own route
2. Open the detailed view and click on the button “show options”
3. Choose the download format – for the navi2coach it is now **o-synce track** – and click on **Add cue sheet**
4. Click on the button “download”
